Each year in Canada, close to 1000 workers will die due to a work-related injury or illness. Each worker leaves behind family, friends and coworkers. Threads of Life offers programs for people impacted by a workplace tragedy, and we want everyone who could benefit from our services to know we exist. Community Engagement volunteers can help make this happen.

How?
