Shannon's father died in a workplace tragedy in 2013. She shares how she answers friends & co-workers who ask why she would go to the forum knowing that it will be sad.

“Yes, there are families grieving, there is sadness, and there are people on different parts of the journey that follows workplace tragedy. But in addition to that sadness there is a great deal of hope and healing that takes place over the three days that we are together. These are people with courage and resilience who understand that although nothing will ever be the same, we will all in time find a way to move forward in our life and find the new normal that we all so desperately want.”

Why Should You Attend?

Losing a loved one to a traumatic workplace injury or disease is devastating to the surviving family, no matter at what age or how many years ago it happened. Along with overwhelming grief, you're thrown into the world of workplace inspections, investigations, coroner's inquests and the court system.

Families living with someone who has suffered from a life-altering injury or occupational disease also walk a difficult and challenging road. Few people understand their trials and tribulations, changed economic circumstances, dramatically altered futures and daily challenges.

Many families feel alone on this new, unexpected journey. Who will understand the magnitude of your loss? Where do you turn to for answers? But most important, where can you find a safe place to further your own healing?

Threads of Life (Association for Workplace Tragedy Family Support) offers families affected by a workplace tragedy the opportunity to attend an annual Forum, where they can come together to share, network, and ultimately, heal. At this unique event, spouses, parents, siblings and close friends gather and learn coping skills for grief, active listening skills, tips on self-care, how the occupational health and safety system works and so much more.



Registration Fee: Free for family members aged 14 and older who register by **August 31, 2018**. We understand that the financial costs to participate in the Family Forum can be a challenge. Through our Steps for Life fundraising walk proceeds, grants and sponsorship support, we are able to offer four immediate family members complimentary accommodations, meals and free registration. When you register there is an expectation that you will attend workshop sessions and be present for all meals. Please be advised that participants will be confirmed on a first-come, first-served basis.
