Who should attend

Anyone whose family has been affected by a work-related fatality, or has had a life-altering injury or occupational disease affect themselves or a loved one. Sessions are recommended for family members 14 years of age and older, who are emotionally ready to heal, share their grief and hear others' experiences.

Why you should attend

When you are coping with a life-altering injury that happened on the job, an occupational disease, or the aftermath of a workplace fatality, you may be feeling very alone. No one understands what you're going through. Friends and family think you should get over it, get on with your life, get back to normal. But your normal is gone. We get it.

Threads of Life (Association for Workplace Tragedy Family Support) offers families affected by a workplace tragedy the opportunity to attend an annual forum, where they can share, network, and ultimately, heal. By attending the Western Family Forum, you will gain:

- Greater understanding of your loss and its impact
- Strategies for coping and healing
- A new network of individuals who have had similar experiences
- The assurance that you're not alone!

Details of the Event

Registration fee: Free for family members aged 14 and older who register by **September 16, 2024**. We understand that the financial costs to participate in the Family Forum can be a challenge. Through our Steps for Life fundraising walk proceeds, grants and sponsorship support, we are able to offer four immediate family members complimentary accommodations, meals and free registration. When you register there is an expectation that you will attend workshop sessions and be present for all meals. Please be advised that participants will be confirmed on a first-come, first-served basis.
